Sedex Auditor Accounts

3 Types of Sedex Auditor Accounts: each with its own registration route.

Independent Auditor – designed for independent individual auditors, allows them to:

- Upload audits.
- Review corrective action plans and sign off non-compliances.
- Allows only one user per account.
- Available for all members; 1st Party and 2nd Party auditors and 3rd Party auditors who are not part of the Audit Company Group or Associate Auditor Group (please see below).

Cost: No charge.

Audit Company Group – designed for audit companies, allows them to:

- Add multiple auditors to the account and centrally manage your company's audits.
- Audit staff can upload audits, review corrective actions and sign off non-compliances.
- Lead user is able to create subsidiary accounts and assign audits to audit staff.
- Available for 3rd party auditing companies only.

Cost: Based on turnover - upwards of £600 per year. Please see application details on our website (www.sedexglobal.com).

Associate Auditor Group (AAG) – designed for audit companies who are part of working group.

- Have the same functionality as Audit Company Group.
- Involved in AAG work group.
- Limited spaces available.

Cost: Based on turnover - upwards of £300 per year. Please see details on our website (www.sedexglobal.com).

Option 1 Independent Auditor

Designed for independent individual auditors

This account allows you to:

- Upload audits.
- Review corrective action plans and sign off non-compliances.
- only one user per account.
- Available for 1st Party, 2nd Party and 3rd Party auditors. This account is available for all auditors.

Cost: No charge.

For an independent auditor account, your supplier must nominate you as their auditor.

Please ask your **supplier** to log on to <u>www.sedexglobal.com</u> and <u>complete</u> Steps 1 - 12.







Supplier selects audit type

There are 3 different Audit Types:

- 1. First Party: carried out by the site itself- internal/self audit-
- 2. Second Party: a customer within the supply chain (Brand, Retailer, Purchaser, Other) auditing their supplier's site.
- 3. Third Party: a neutral third party auditing company, independent of the supply chain. If you select third party, please see next slide for details on what to enter.

Entering the correct Audit Type is very important as this allows the supplier to correctly select their chosen auditor.

Option 2 Audit Company Group

Designed for commercial audit companies

This account allows you to:

- Add multiple auditors to the account and centrally manage your company's audits.
- Audit staff can upload audits, review corrective actions and sign off non-compliances.
- Lead user is able to create subsidiary accounts and assign audits to audit staff.
- Available for 3rd party auditing companies only.

Cost: Based on turnover - upwards of £600 per year.





Audit Company Group

As the number of global auditors using the system has increased, other audit companies are interested in improving their 'Sedex experience'. For this reason, we have created another auditor group – 'the Audit Company Group'. Membership of this group gives extra functionality on the system.

Benefits

Members of the Audit Company Group receive the following benefits:

- permanent log-in facilities to Sedex
- prepopulated email address on the Sedex system, making it easier for a supplier to select you as their chosen auditor
- access to B member self assessment data once you have been nominated as an audit partner of that member
- access to non-compliance and other data relating to audit reports uploaded by your own company
- central view of your own audit company's audit data

Designed for audit companies who are part of the AAG working group

This account allows you to:

- Have the same functionality as Audit Company Group.
- Involved in AAG work group.
- Limited spaces available.

Cost: Based on turnover - upwards of £300 per year.





The AAG

The AAG is a Sedex working group made up of commercial auditing companies and NGOs that are significantly involved in ethical trade auditing, with active participation from Sedex members. As a working group there is a limit on member numbers.

The purpose of the AAG is to drive convergence in ethical trade/social auditing, based on, and helping to shape, best practice.
